



Rejoicing is open to all, even those of us who take life a little too seriously.

So this New Year's let us Rejoice. Our God loves us and is always doing a new thing, even when we don't know it or may not be at the heart of it. God is moving. God is moving in our world, in our nation, in our communities, in our families, in our lives and in our churches. God moves. This is cause for great rejoicing!

O Lord, you are a God who is always creating and working. Thank you for bringing us to another new year, 2023. May the new year be filled with you Lord. You in the form of moments with those in need, you in the form of moments with family, you in the form of moments of redemption and forgiveness, you in the form of humility, you in the form of the great Joy that you bring into our lives. 


