



# **Please Note:**

Are you looking for a way to save on taxes? Do you already give regularly to the Church? Are you 70 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> or older? **Doing a Qualified Charitable** Distribution may be worth looking into.

What is a qualified charitable distribution?

Generally, a qualified charitable distribution is an otherwise taxable distribution from an IRA (other than an ongoing SEP or SIMPLE IRA) owned by an individual who is age 701/2 or over that is paid directly from the IRA to a qualified charity. This allows you to lower your adjusted gross income (AGI) while also satisfying the

required minimum distribution (RMD) amounts set by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). This can help offset other taxes, such as Social Security. If you are interested in using a Qualified Charitable Distribution for your yearly tithe please contact your tax personnel for assistance.
