Present: Pastor Susan, Judi, Chelsey, Rita, Kendale, Jill, Jeremy, Gary, and Carrie

GUMC Administrative Council met on August 7,2024 at 6:30pm. Gary opened with a devotion and prayer. Susan followed with 2 Corinthians 2:12 and a discussion was had about how this relates to the churches finances and giving.

At 6:58 pm Gary called the meeting to order.

Rita made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 5,2024 and July 14, 2024 meetings. 2nd by Carrie. Motion carried.

### **Old Business:**

- -Mission opportunity in July: Took leftover pie, chicken, and potatoes from 4th of July to the Beacon of Hope.
- -Mission opportunity in August: School kits and health kits for ingathering information can be found in the narthex.
- -Reviewed ministry goals for 2024.
- -Discussed Gowrie's Downtown Market on August 22 and September 12. Sign up sheet will be passed for volunteers to set up a table with crafts and giveaways for community outreach.
- -Discussed hosting a walking taco meal during garage sales on Friday, September 6th during the lunch hour. Gary will find volunteers to help serve, Carrie and Judi will work on getting food items donated.
- -Discussed other fundraising and fellowship ideas for this fall. Lasagna dinner will be November 10th following worship. Chelsey will organize.
- -Discussed church finances. \$158,000 is needed to operate our church for the 2024 year. With inflation, that is expected to go up in 2025. Conversation was had on how accounts are low on funds and what can be done to encourage more giving.
- -Deb will be resigning as treasurer. Ryan and Anna Cottington will be taking her place. The three of them will work together to transition. Encouraged prayers for them.

### **New Business:**

- -Discussed recommended honorariums for funerals. Ned Palmer contacted Susan about this. Jeremy made a motion for tech to receive \$60 and custodian to receive \$100 for honorariums for funerals. 2nd by Judi. Motion carried.
- -Need for finance chair and an additional at large member were tabled for next month.
- -Charge conference 2024 tabled for next month.

### **Work Area Reports:**

- -Trustees Judi reported Ben Johnson has ordered the windows and materials.
- -Kendale made the motion to rollover the Parsonage CD at Heartland Bank in the amount of \$125,078.94 to 10 months at 4.2%, bringing it to June 2025. 2nd Carrie. Motion carried. Susan and Judi will contact Heartland Bank.
- -Education- Chelsey reported VBS was a success. New Sunday School curriculum will be ordered soon.
