

D.S. Michel Lundala has challenged each Worshiping community in the Camp Clear Lake District to go out to



our Jerusalem (which would be Gowrie and the surrounding area), to our Samaria (the surrounding communities) and the whole world. He has asked us *as a church body* (as a community of faith) to reach out, to love and to serve those around us. To invite, to include, to befriend. To share our stories of life and faith. To listen to the stories of others. To do those things that a church body is called to in its unique place and time.

This past Charge Conference, each Worshiping community was asked to share how we reached out past the walls of our building and our comfortable relationships into the community. We were able to share the mission focuses we held throughout the year of 2023. We shared about Trunk or Treat and Christmas Bazaar's etc.

The challenge goes deeper as we love and serve. The challenge is about how we as a Body of Christ are both *connecting as individuals and as a united Body* with the community around us. We have our individual faith story, and our faith story as a united Body of Christ. The challenge is about building relationships and coming along side our community.

<u>Psalm 96:3</u> says "Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all peoples!" We are to proclaim our story, our story of Jesus love and salvation. It is through this story that others come to know Christ. This is the purpose of the "Church" of the Body we are part of here at Gowrie United Methodist Church.

Our Missional Priorities for Gowrie UMC are consistent with Psalm 96 and our Rev. Lundalas hope for our congregation. They are:

Mission Priority #1: Connecting with our neighbors, community members and church members; and intentionally inviting them to small gatherings outside the church building/community and inside the church building/community. Joining in fellowship and play together.

Missional priority #2: Sharing our faith and connecting with others in deeper ways that nurture supportive and caring relationships where our faith is shared.

Let us continue to go forth. God is working in Gowrie UMC and transformation is at hand.




