CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES January 8, 2025 @ 6:30-8:00 pm

Opened with devotion and prayer lead by Pastor Susan Rohden. Introduction of guest Ron Carlson, Iowa Annual Conference Treasurer. Minutes taken by Carrie Dalley and Pastor Susan Rohden. Present: Carrie Dalley, Kendale Vosberg, Rita Kail, Jeremy Viles, Jill Viles, Crystal Wilks, Chelsey Worell, Anna Cottington, Judi Tjepkes, Pastor Susan Rohden, Rev. Ron Calson

Council discussion with Rev. Carlson about church financials.

SPRC asked questions about housing allowance. Ron referred SPRC to discuss using the parsonage sale fund for the housing allowance to our D.S., Rev. Dr. Michel Lundula. The parsonage fund can be used for capital improvements and Pastoral housing allowance.

Ron expressed that it appeared our church was living within it's means and had no budget items that appeared inappropriate. Ron noted that our church has paid apportionments 100% for the last several years. Ron reflected that the stressors we are experiencing are being experienced by many congregations.

Ron encouraged our leadership and congregation to develop a clear sense of who we are and what our mission is in our community. He expressed that trouble comes when congregations are stuck in the way that things have been in years past and are not able to see, support or allow a future with new ways of approaching things for a new generation. Also it is very important to have a positive attitude and outlook.


Ron offered that he is always available to talk things through.

At the end of the meeting, Pastor shared that we need to think about what we would like to do during Lent. Zion has expressed an interest in continuing to do Soup suppers but this has began to be challenging for us. We will continue this discussion in Feb. Pastor also shared that she and Glenn are planning a Wesley pilgrimage to London next summer and will coordinate with the committee who manages the Pastoral Travel fund.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
