
"SAVIOR, SERVANT, FRIEND" WEDNESDAY SERVICES FOR LENT







The minutes were taken by Kendale.

Review of December and January minutes were moved to approve by Chelsey and seconded by Gary-motion carried

The Board reviewed December mission and ministries for our church and the January weekly offerings.

Old Business: We continued the discussion about the quilt/themed basket action, possibly on April 27 with beef burgers and bars. We also discussed the Lenten suppers and services coming in March and April. Chelsey and Anna suggested at our meeting on April 8th, we could put together 10 crockpots for the supper on the 9th. We also continued our finance discussion, and went over our 2025 budget. Chelsey moved that we approve the 2025 church budget with the exception of the Christian Education Fund being brought down to \$1000.00. The motion was 2nd by Gary-motion carried. Anna will shift the newest window funds out of the general fund, and will transfer funds in from the Money Market, so we have a buffer in our account for automatic bill withdrawals. We plan to continue to pay church apportionments when we are able. It was decided that basic financials for the month will be placed in the newsletter, to keep the congregation informed. Pastor went over a brochure for giving that she and Carrie have been working on. Pastor will share this brochure with the congregation.

New Business: Shrove Tuesday is March 4th. Council decided to go back to serving pancakes for this. Gary will contact Verne and call people. Chelsey and Anna have frozen left over lasagna sauce from the Christmas bazaar. They thought we could get together and put a meal together for the Beacon of Hope in Fort Dodge. Maybe in March? Pastor Susan will check on this. Work Area Reports: Gary made a motion and Rita seconded to approve Treasurer's report for January. Two boxes of hats, mittens/gloves, pants were collected by our church this Christmas and taken to the elementary school. The 2024 statistics report has been completed and submitted. Pastor Susan is planning for Lent and Holy week.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm Next meeting scheduled for March 6th at 6:30 pm
