PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

Grace and Peace to you in the name of the Father, the Son and the Spirit.

The Lord replied, "If you had faith the size of a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." Luke 17:6

Faith like a "mustard seed". Pastor Arulnathan of Churdan, shared with me once, that the mustard seed Jesus is referring to is much smaller than the mustard seed we think of here in the States. Regardless we know that the mustard seed is small compared to most things. In reality I wonder if most of us live out our lives with mustard seed faith because doubts, fears and uncertainty impact our faith. We may think of "mustard seed" faith as a negative but Jesus tells us our "mustard seed" faith is remarkable!

For we must remember that as Christians, we place "mustard seed" faith in God who is all powerful. Nothing on this earth compares to who God is and what God can do. God's mission of creation and love defies human understanding. What we do know is that if through the Holy Spirit, we are <u>listening</u> to God's voice, <u>doing</u> God's will and <u>having "Mustard Seed" faith</u> in God and not in ourselves, <u>God does amazing things</u>. On October 12th, we will gather together as a church and look to the future, let us remember the power of "Mustard See" faith.





Congregational Gathering discussion.


